Judge Sherrill A. Ellsworth is the Past Presiding Judge of Riverside County, California, a Judicial Educator and former Family Law Judge. Judge Ellsworth was one of the court's most respected and admired bench officers, earning the trust and revere of her colleagues and the lawyers who appeared before her. She was appointed as a voting member of California State's Judicial Council in 2013.
